



Remit: 1-5 and 1-10 Centre Tournaments

Background:

There is some confusion on which teams should play off against each other in the final stages. There is also a discrepancy between the conditions of play in the centre handbook and what happens in practice. It would be good to ensure consistency across the following tournaments:

1-10 Year 2x4x2 Pairs

1-5 Year 2x4x2 Pairs

1-5 Year Singles

Remit:

For each of these tournaments (Men and Women)

- Start of first game 8:30am
- All games 1hr 10mins with no requirement on ends played or points scored. Singles will complete at 21 points if this is reached before the bell.
- A killed end is replayed unless after the bell in which case the Jack/Kitty is placed on the 2m mark
- Top four teams/players after four rounds progress to semi-final
 - Top qualifier plays bottom qualifier
 - 2nd plays 3rd qualifier
- In the semi-final and final a tied game after the bell will require a single tie-break end
- Short break after game 1, 30 min lunch at completion of game 3.



Remit: Team/Club Placings in Pennants

Background:

There are differences in the way that byes, games cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances and the scoring systems are run between each of the Pennants and Interclub tournaments. To make life easier going forward it would be good to have some consistency which will make the recording and distribution of scores a little easier.

Proposal:

Team/Club Performance for East Zone Wednesday Pennants, Ladies Interclub and Saturday Pennants calculation becomes:

(total points from games played / total possible points from games played) * 100

This will remove the current requirement to award points for a bye or when only some of the games in the centre are cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances i.e. a weather event in one area that does not stop play in another.

For clarity:

- If a game is started but then abandoned due to unforeseen circumstances the score will only count if six or more ends are completed.
- A defaulting team is awarded zero points the opposing team is awarded maximum points.

The results for the league table will then show clubs in order of percentage performance i.e. a team that wins half of their games would be at 50% etc.
