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President's Message

Welcome to the 2026/27 bowling season and once again it's shaping up as an exciting and busy one.

Over the winter period the Bowls Central Otago Board has been very busy planning and preparing for a very full calendar in the upcoming season. We welcome Tania Holden (ADC) and Jean O'Callaghan (Arrowtown) to the Board and more recently Stu Greer (Ranfurly). Stu was co-opted in July and will bring a Maniatoto perspective to any discussions. We farewell John Lochhead (Alexandra), Margaret O'Connor (Queenstown) and Maria Wallis (Clyde) from the Board and I offer my sincere thanks for the contributions they have made in the time I have served with them and prior to then.

In further developing the centre's Strategic Plan the Board has adopted the following by-line:

*"It's not about you and your club
It's not about me and my club
It's about us and our clubs"*

The Board is looking to promote the view that we are all working together to attain better outcomes for all. The last thing we need is for clubs to fail with a subsequent loss of members and playing surfaces. We currently have 16 member clubs, 15 natural greens and 5 artificial greens. The population in our area is growing faster than anywhere else in New Zealand so the opportunity exists

to grow our membership numbers. On that note, hats off to Roxburgh club which had 44 people attend their AGM in July and in attracting 13 new members. This followed some very strategic marketing and already they have a plan in place to initiate those new members into the club and the sport of bowling.

Pleasingly, we have two extra teams in Division 2 Saturday pennants which extends their playing season. Additionally, following a very good end of season meeting with our women bowlers several of them have developed a new tournament programme similar to what is played fortnightly in the men's West Zone, Wednesday pennants.

Clearly, a highlight from last season was the Maria Wallis inspired Novice programme. Held in September, it attracted 60+ year 1-2 bowlers. From this initiative numbers swelled in our Year 1-5 Singles Championships (Men – 34 from 14 the previous season) and (Women – 24 from 18). This has necessitated setting aside a full weekend for the Year 1-5 Singles in the coming season. The Board is currently planning to hold an abbreviated session (taken from last year) for Novice bowlers followed by a tournament for Year 1-3 bowlers. Once the programme is finalised clubs will be advised accordingly.

As of last season, Bowls Central Otago had 571 bowlers registered on Bowls Hub. This represents about 75% of our bowling fraternity and we would be surprised if there is a higher percentage anywhere else in New Zealand. Bowls Central Otago will continue to promote Bowls

Hub to its members clubs in the 2026/27 season. With the interest in the programme and our competitions we want to have as many individuals as possible able to input results as they happen e.g. immediately after Saturday Pennants. On that note, it is vital full names are recorded on the cards and not nicknames or simply “substitute”. Incomplete detail means no player from that game receives national ranking points.

A highlight from the season past was the performance of the Arrowtown pairing of Kelvin Jackson and Allan Brash in reaching the quarter finals of the Australian Open so congratulations are in order. Over a season we have a high number of our bowlers competing at high profile events such as the Australian Open. Somehow, it would be great to know who and where so our Publicity Officer, Barbara Wilson can promote this throughout our region.

2026/27 will be no different in terms of risks and challenges and a Club Presidents meeting has been scheduled in September to talk these through. As always finance is one of these, at all levels. The Board will continue to look at how it can attract extra funding to support its initiatives on behalf of our member clubs, success at the elite level and likely, most importantly, the retention and maintenance of our 20 playing surfaces.

Finally, we wish our 16 member clubs, all players, coaches, officials and administrators the very best for the upcoming season. Let it be a season where each and every one of us is focused on improvement be it on the green or

helping out around the club. There is much to be gained if we are all prepared to pitch in.

Conditions of Play

Laws and Regulations / Code of Conduct: All competitions must be played in accordance with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls, Crystal Mark Fourth Edition effective 1 April 2023 and players must adhere to Bowls Central Otago Inc. Code of Conduct dated 2 October 2022.

Absentee players: (Law 39) If player/s are absent in a team or side the game may continue. Law 39 will apply.

Leaving the Venue: No player shall leave a venue at any competition without reporting to the Umpire.

Catering: Players will make their own arrangements for lunch unless otherwise stated.

Mobile Phones: Use is not permitted by players on or alongside the greens during play. Cell phones should be switched off or on silent.

Smoking/Vaping: Teams/Players must abide by the rules of Host Club. No Smoking/Vaping in Clubrooms, on greens or surroundings at Centre events.

Entries: All players in Centre Events must be full-financial members of a club affiliated with Bowls Central Otago Inc. Entries for all Centre Tournaments MUST be registered on Bowls Hub by the closing date.

Entry fees: All singles events \$35.00. All other Centre Events \$30.00/player including morning and afternoon tea. To be paid in full to Bowls Central Otago (Bowls CO), Bank Account 02 0916 0133831 00 by Monday prior to the

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event. Entries will not be included in draw unless payment in full received by due date.

Centre Titles: The following open events qualify for a Centre Title: Singles, Pairs, Triples, Fours, Mixed Pairs, Interclub 7s.

Clothing: All players must wear their club uniform.

Time: Play will commence by 8.30am each day.

Controlling Body: The Controlling Body for these events is the Bowls Central Otago Match Committee. The Controlling Body will have the right to alter, add or delete any conditions of play due to unfavourable weather and/or special conditions to enable the completion of the tournament. Each event will be under the control of a Tournament Manager appointed by Bowls Central Otago Inc.

Markers: Competitors must bring 1 marker between 2 players.

Substitutes (Domestic Regulation 2): Any change in players is subject to the prior approval of the Controlling Body and is limited to one substitute in Pairs and Triples and two for Fours. No substitute will be approved for Open Singles. 1–5 Competitions may substitute for the runner-up. The substitute must play in any position other than skip. The other members of the team can rearrange their positions as necessary. Application forms must be submitted to the Controlling Body and are available from www.bowlscentralotago.com.

Prizes: Prize money will be determined by Bowls Central Otago Inc.

Score Cards: (Law 40.1.7) The skip MUST be responsible for the score card supplied by the Controlling Body while play is in progress (40.1.7.1). Names of all players to be entered. At the end of the game, record finishing time. Both skips MUST sign.

Trial Ends: (Law 5.1) Before the scheduled start of play each day, before continuing an unfinished game on another day or if changing greens during the day, one trial end may be played in each direction at the discretion of the Controlling Body. All players and bowls must be off the green at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled commencement times of the event.

Practice Ends: (Law 4.0) If a team has a bye in the first round of the day, they will be entitled to practice on another available rink, which they will not be playing on during the day as designated by the Controlling Body. They will also be entitled to trial ends, on their first rink of play, along with their opponents. If a team has a bye in a subsequent round, they will only be entitled to practice on another available rink as designated by the Controlling Body.

Complaints: The Match Committee will act on complaints and disputes, provided they comply with Law 36 or 52.4. All complaints and disputes must be forwarded in writing, on the appropriate form, to: Bowls Central Otago Inc.

Presentation Night: Trophies, badges and cash prizes will be presented at the Bowls Central Otago Presentation Evening at the end of the season.

Saturday Pennants

Premier, Divisions 1 & 2 — Conditions of Play

Teams: May consist of men or mixed teams.

Players: May move between divisions although this is not encouraged.

Start Time: 1.00pm unless otherwise advised.

Match Format: Game 1 – 1½ hours Fours. Game 2 – 1½ hours, 3 Bowl Pairs for Premier and Div 1, 2x4x2 for Div 2.

Team Format: Pairs combinations and opponents should be decided before commencement of fours and toss done to see which pair plays which.

Scoring: Fours — 2 points for a win, 1 point for a draw. Pairs — 2 points for a win, 1 point for a draw. 1 aggregate point to the team with the most points across both games. If the points are tied ½ point is awarded to both teams.

Killed End: A killed end is replayed unless it is after the bell when it is replaced on the 2 metre mark.

Incorrectly Delivered Jack: Placed by the opposing skip.

Catering: Afternoon tea provided by the host club.

Games interrupted or called off: If a game is interrupted and subsequently no further play is possible due to inclement weather or any other valid reason, the following rules will apply:

- If play is called off before the fours game is complete, then there is no result.
- If the fours are completed those points are awarded.
- If the pairs have completed 6 ends the points will be awarded, otherwise the points are shared.
- If games cannot be played on the day they must be played before the next round OR the teams can share the points OR one club will need to default.

Defaults: If a club is unable to field all its teams on a Saturday it MUST default its lowest ranking team or teams. All defaults to be approved by the controlling body.

Duties of Host Club:

- Appoint a controller for the afternoon.
- Allocate rinks for all games before play commences and displayed for all players to see.
- Create scorecards which must include the discipline e.g. Premier, Pairs 1, Club vs Club and Rink No.
- Ensure the toss is done to determine which pairs play each other.
- Start the event and be responsible for the bell/horn and time clock.

All results to be entered into Bowls Hub by the Host Club directly from cards, once signed.

Final Results — Premier, Division 1 and Division 2:

- Each team accumulates points, in their own right, during the round robin.

- At the completion of the round robin in Premier and Division 1, the top four teams will progress to the semi-finals. 1st vs 4th and 2nd vs 3rd will apply. The winner of each game plays off in the final. The losers may play off to determine 3rd and 4th.
- At the completion of the round robin in Division 2 the top two teams in their respective sections will progress to the semi-finals: 1st section 1 vs 2nd section 2, and 2nd section 1 vs 1st section 2. The winner of each game plays off in the final. Losers may play off to determine 3rd and 4th.

Restrictions — Premier:

- Only players who have played a minimum of five pennants rounds (in any division) can play for their team on finals day.
- Once a player has played five pennants rounds in the Premier division, he or she is ineligible to play in Division 1 or 2.

Divisions 1 & 2:

- Only players who have played a minimum of five pennants rounds in a particular team can play for that team on finals day should it qualify.
- The Hurley Cup will be awarded to the winners of the Premier Division.
- The Clyde Trophy will be awarded to the winners of Division 1.
